She has almost nothing and yet she has chosen to try to give more. Nyirasafar then became quite sick last year and had to give up selling fish. She had to go to the hospital and have surgery. The Lord has

blessed Nyirasafar with a full recovery today, but she is once again faced with providing an income for her family.

This is where Land of a Thousand Hills Coffee helps. Nyirasafar has received a loan from us for \$91. Her vision is to create a store that will sell second hand clothes for a profit. This will enable her to repay the loan, buy food for her children, and provide an education and medical treatment for her entire family.
